

TEACH THE CLASS PROJECT

You are a smart, talented person who knows how to many useful things. Now it is up to you to let your classmates know just how interesting you are. This is your time to shine, so follow each step below to ensure success.

1. Make a list of several things you are either good at, or interested in. Discuss this list with the class or the teacher, and consider how you might present your talent to the class in a 5-10 minute presentation.
2. Think about all the steps involved in teaching someone how to do something new. Consider what sort of background info they might need to understand what you will teach them and why they should know how to do what it is you are demonstrating.
3. On a piece of paper, number and briefly describe each step in your teaching demonstration. Think about all the small details, and don't miss anything.
4. Meet with your teacher to discuss your teaching presentation before moving forward.
5. Now that you have a list of steps, fully write out/explain each of the steps involved in a way that someone who didn't see your teaching demo could easily understand or do what you were trying to teach them.
6. Meet with your teacher to discuss your teaching presentation before moving forward.
7. Using the brief descriptions of each step (not the fully detailed explanations) create a PowerPoint presentation in which each step corresponds to its own slide. On each slide, you should have the step you will be explaining in your presentation clearly visible, along with a picture for each step. Remember, the PowerPoint should be a general guide for your presentation, not the presentation itself. That it what you are here for!
8. Meet with your teacher to discuss your teaching presentation before moving forward. You must have approval before you present.

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
